

Minuet in A minor

Johann Sebastian Bach

BWV Anh. 120

The first system of the Minuet in A minor, measures 1-8. The music is in 3/4 time and A minor. The right hand features a melodic line with eighth and sixteenth notes, while the left hand provides a steady accompaniment of eighth notes.

The second system of the Minuet in A minor, measures 9-17. It begins with a repeat sign at measure 9. The right hand continues the melodic development with slurs and ties, while the left hand maintains the accompaniment.

The third system of the Minuet in A minor, measures 18-24. It features trills (tr) in both hands at measures 19, 20, 21, and 23. The piece concludes with a final cadence in measure 24.
