The first system of music, numbered 4, is in G major and common time. It begins with a piano (p) dynamic. The right hand features a melody of eighth notes, while the left hand provides a steady accompaniment of chords. The system concludes with a fermata over the final chord.

The second system, numbered 9, continues the piece. It maintains the same melodic and harmonic structure as the first system, ending with a fermata.

The third system, numbered 17, shows the continuation of the musical theme. The right hand's melody and the left hand's accompaniment are consistent with the previous systems, ending with a fermata.

The fourth system, numbered 25, is the final system of the piece. It concludes the 'Un choral' with a fermata over the final chord.
